



FREDERICK DOUGLASS HBCU FOOTBALL CLASSIC | A new event in 2024, the RPF acted as a financial and logistical partner in helping to bring together this amazing community-focused football game featuring two HBCU universities, as well as a local job fair, guest speaker events, and battle of the bands.



STOP THE BLEED INITIATIVE | As part of the "Stop The Bleed" national initiative, the Foundation funded the acquisition of tourniquets for all RPD patrol officers to have in case of traumatic injury out in the field, for themselves or citizens. These have already been used several times to save lives in our community.




